### ACCOMPLISHMENTS

40 Major Open Championship titles; many Runner-up laurels, hundreds of placements with dozens of dogs. The first of these wins came in the late 1950's.

The list includes the coveted National Championship with Quicksilver Pink, a contender he piloted to ten Open Championship victories and the Purina Top Dog Award. Today she has her place in the Field Trial Hall of Fame.

Colvin has won titles in Championships such as the National Free-For-All, four times; Southern Championship, three times; Quail Championship Invitational, and all Chicken Championships on the Canadian prairies numerous times.

He has to his credit three Purina Top Dog Awards with three different dogs, two Handler of the Year Awards and many other recognitions of excellence.

### GIVING BACK

Judging numerous trials throughout the country including Quail Championship Invitational, Western Open Championships, American Derby Invitational Championship, U. S. Championship.

He has been instrumental in forming field trial clubs and hosting them in Alabama and Canada and in bringing field trials back to Broomhill, Manitoba which today hosts the Manitoba Championship, John S. Gates Memorial Derby, Pelican Open All-Age, and the Broomhill Open All-Age (formerly the Iron Nation).

In 1995, Colvin established the Broomhill Field Trial Foundation, a scholarship fund that benefits the children of the area.

He works alongside key political figures, neighbors and landowners with the Department of Wildlife in hopes of opening new lands in Manitoba for trainers to obtain licenses.

### THE MAN

Colvin is a family man, dog man, sportsman and above all, a gentleman. His life and love are his family — his passion, bird dogs and field trials. Though he has come full circle, Colvin continues in his efforts to make field trialing a better sport, one that will be here for generations to come. His contagious good spirit, generosity and positive attitude make field trials enjoyable for all those around him.
